



We are pleased that New Hope Baptist Church is open for face to face worship services in our Sanctuary. It is very important that we observe safe social distancing practices as given by the CDC, Governor McMaster, and outlined by the South Carolina Health and Human Services Department. Below are several safe social distancing practices that New Hope will be observing. We hope that these will make you feel more comfortable as you attend the services.

- If you are sick or believe you may have been exposed to the virus, we ask that you please stay home. Please consult with your health care provider for quarantine instructions.
- As you enter the building be sure and maintain six feet of separation.
- Please use hand sanitizer, which is located in the foyer.
- Keep at least six feet separation between parties (i.e. families) in any row. For example, two families on one row should have six feet of separation between the two families.
- Offering plates will not be passed but are available in the front of the sanctuary. You can place your offering in the plates before the service or during the offertory hymn. You can also mail your offerings to the church office.
- After the services, please exit while maintaining six feet of separation. We ask that you please not congregate in the foyer.
- Feel free to wear masks and gloves. Please be aware they are not required and that there may be attendees without masks and gloves.
- The cleaning service will continue to clean before and after our Sunday and Wednesday services.
